Message: “Who God Has Chosen”

Theme: Loving impartially takes an alert, vigilant attitude of concern because it’s so easy to fall into worldly habits of selfishness and favoritism.

Scriptures: Luke 4:16-30 and James 2:1-9

Key Verse: Luke 4:18

Message: “Responding to God’s Call”

Theme: Are we willing to lovingly respond to God’s call to be fishers of men even to those we may perceive to be enemies?

Scripture Readings: Mark 1:14-20 and Jonah 3:1-5, 10

Key Verse: Mark 1:17

Jan. 28th: 4th Sunday after the Epiphany

Message: “The Gospel and Discernment”

Theme: Sometimes we need a bold confrontive approach in sharing Christ; other times we need careful analysis and discernment in knowing how to communicate Christ effectively.

Scripture Readings: Mark 1:21-28 and Corinthians 8:1-13

Key Verse: I Corinthians 8:9
