Dec. 6th: 2nd Sunday of Advent

Message: "What Waiting Requires"

Theme: As we wait upon the Lord, let us allow Him to work within us to build our character.

Scripture Readings: Isaiah 40:1-11 and II Peter 3:8-15a

Key Verse: Isaiah 40:3

Holy Communion

Dec. 13th: 3rd Sunday of Advent

Message: "The Joy of the Lord is Our Strength"

Theme: Whatever dark times we go through in life, knowing that God is with us can fill us with joy, a joy that gives us renewed strength to face what lies ahead.

Scripture Readings: Philippians 4:4-8 and Luke 1:39-56

Key Verse: Nehemiah 8:10c "...do not be grieved, for the joy of the Lord is your strength."

Dec. 20th: 4th Sunday of Advent

Message: "Lovingly Proclaim the Gospel"

Theme: We are called to speak the truth in love, to lovingly share with others how God sent His Son Jesus to be our Savior.

Scripture Readings: I John 1:5-9 and Luke 3:1-16

Key Verse: I Peter 3:15-16

Dec. 24th: Christmas Eve (5 PM Service)

Message: "Whoever Takes the Son Gets It All"

Theme: When we accept Christ as Savior and Lord we receive every bit of God's mercy, grace and love.

Scripture Readings: Isaiah 9:1-7 and Luke 2:1-20

Key verse: Isaiah 9:6

Dec. 27th: 1st Sunday after Christmas

Message: "The Word Became Flesh to Make Us His Heirs"

Theme: God took on flesh in Jesus in order to claim us and restore us, because He loves us.

Scripture Readings: Galatians 4:4-7 and John 1:1-14

Key Verse: "And the Word became flesh and lived among us, and we have seen his glory, the glory as of a father's only son, full of grace and truth." John 1:14
